





A nurturing and creative world.

Tuition & Fees

HAWAII

MONTHLY TUITION COST:
\$795 PER STUDENT (3 & 4 YR. CLASS)
\$895 PER STUDENT (2 YR. CLASS)

Tuition includes a nutritious breakfast, lunch and snacks each day. Tuition is due on the first school day of each month, and will not be prorated due to holidays, school or family vacations, in-service days or other absences.

NON-REFUNDABLE APPLICATION FEE: \$40 PER CHILD

Application Fee is to be submitted with completed application.

DEPOSIT: \$400 PER CHILD

This deposit is required to reserve your child's space in the class, upon enrollment. This deposit will be applied to the last month tuition payment.

ANNUAL SUPPLY FEE: \$100

A non-refundable fee of \$100 per child is charged annually to cover general supply costs and is due by the first day of school.

LATE PAYMENT / RETURNED CHECK FEES: \$25

If tuition payment is not received before the end of business day on the 10th of the month, a late fee will be charged.

LATE PICKUP FEE: \$1 PER MINUTE PAST 5:30PM

There will be a late pick-up charge of \$1 for every minute after 5:30pm. Late fees are due at the time of pick-up and are to be paid to the teacher.

TERMINATION POLICY

Either party with proper notice may terminate care and the child care agreement at anytime for any reason. Proper notice will consist of a 30 day written notice along with full payment to cancel our agreement. If care is terminated without proper notice, payment is still expected.

AGES

Kroc Keiki Learning Center is a licensed group care center for children ages 2-5. Enrollment opens in March 2012 for toilet trained 3-4 year olds. The 2 year old program is anticipated to open at a later date.

TEACHER TO STUDENT RATIOS

The state licensing requirements will always be met, but we believe that smaller class sizes result in a higher quality program and will strive to meet NAEYC accreditation recommendations of a 1:10, teacher to student ratio with an average of under twenty children per classroom.

These will include various release forms, a developmental history, Student's Health Record, form 14, from your child's pediatrician. The Department of Human Services requires us to have information on your child's last physical exam (within one year of starting school) immunization records and TB clearance.
